## Golf Activities

### Handicap Committee

Hello everyone,

Welcome back to the 2020/2021 season from your Handicap Committee. Here are some things we want to remind you of whether you are playing in a WGA/MGA event or on your own in a casual round:

1. Post EVERY score EVERY time you play on the SAME DAY you play.

2. Until rakes are replaced, whenever your ball comes to rest in a disturbed area of a bunker, you may take a free drop within one club length no closer to the hole, or you may play your ball as it lies.

If your ball comes to rest in an undisturbed area, you must play it as it lies.

3. Local rules forbid hitting out of any native penalty area. If your ball goes into a native area, you must play your next ball anywhere on the line between where you hit the ball from and where it crossed into the penalty area with a one stroke penalty. In the interest of speed of play, do not enter the native area to find your ball.

## **Kasia Kay**

From the very beginning I was passionate about sport in school, immersing myself in the swimming team and winning many track and field accolades in javelin, long jump, high jump, and cross country running. My first love however was horse jumping, I have been riding horses since I was six years old, my parents own a small stable with four horses at home in Poland. Unfortunately, when I was seventeen, I had a horse accident the day before a competition. I woke up in the hospital where they told me that I broke my spine, and I would never walk again. I spent six months in a wheelchair determined to get back my normal, active life. When I finally started walking, and was able to do sports again, I was introduced to golf. I have not looked back. Winning a small competition at the local golf course the first time I held a golf club, ignited my love of this game. Eager to improve I dedicated myself to practicing and was very soon winning Polish golfing competitions. In 2008 I won as an amateur in my handicap group and represented Poland in the Amateur World Golf Championships in South Africa. I finished 8th overall but 1st as a woman. Since moving to Los Angeles over 10 years ago I've continued to play and have been training at the David Leadbetter School in Florida, then with Jay Lim, and now Micheal Bantley (Charley Hoffman's coach). I'm proud to have become the face of golf in Poland after being approached by the Polish Golf Association. I've have won many golf tournaments in Poland and I was the best female player in my country. I have been blessed in my life to be able to travel the world and play some of the most prestigious golf courses and tournaments around the world. After my third attempt at LPGA Q School, I received my Symetra Tour card starting the 2017 season. I am also an ambassador to numerous golf brands including Miura, Taylormade, Truespec, Oaklay. I'm very excited to have relocated to La Quinta where I can continue working on my game and get ready for the 2021 season.

## **Jim Schreiber**

Jim is originally from the Chicago area and a lifetime member of the PGA of America. He is a graduate of Arizona State University where he was also on the golf team with such PGA standouts as Tom Purtzer, Howard Twitty and Bob Gilder. He surprised many of them with his runner-up finish in the Arizona State Amateur in 1971.

Jim comes to Desert Falls with a wealth of golf business and teaching experience. He was the Head Golf Professional at Edgewood Valley Country Club in LaGrange Illinois, Terravita Golf in Scottsdale, Arizona and Tripoli Country Club in Milwaukee, Wisconsin before retiring to the Coachella Valley. During his time as a Head Professional, he has given lessons to all skill and age levels of golfers from juniors, college golfers, men, women, those with disabilities and professionals. He has received teacher of the year nominations in his local PGA sections. Since 2013, he has been the lead instructor for the Jeff Symmonds Golf Schools as well as providing private golf instruction in the area. For the last two years, Jim has also been a certified Callaway golf fitter and demo day representative. Over his years in the golf business, Jim has worked golf schools with such famous golf instructors such as Jim Flick, Mike Bender and David Pelz. He has also qualified and competed in the National Club Professional and Senior Club Professional Championships.

In working with a student, Jim does first like to see the golfer play a few holes and get to know their game before taking them to the range to develop a plan that works best for the student with their physical attributes. Jim uses video and teaching aids in his lessons. He also instructs the student how to practice better to improve all parts of their golf game.
